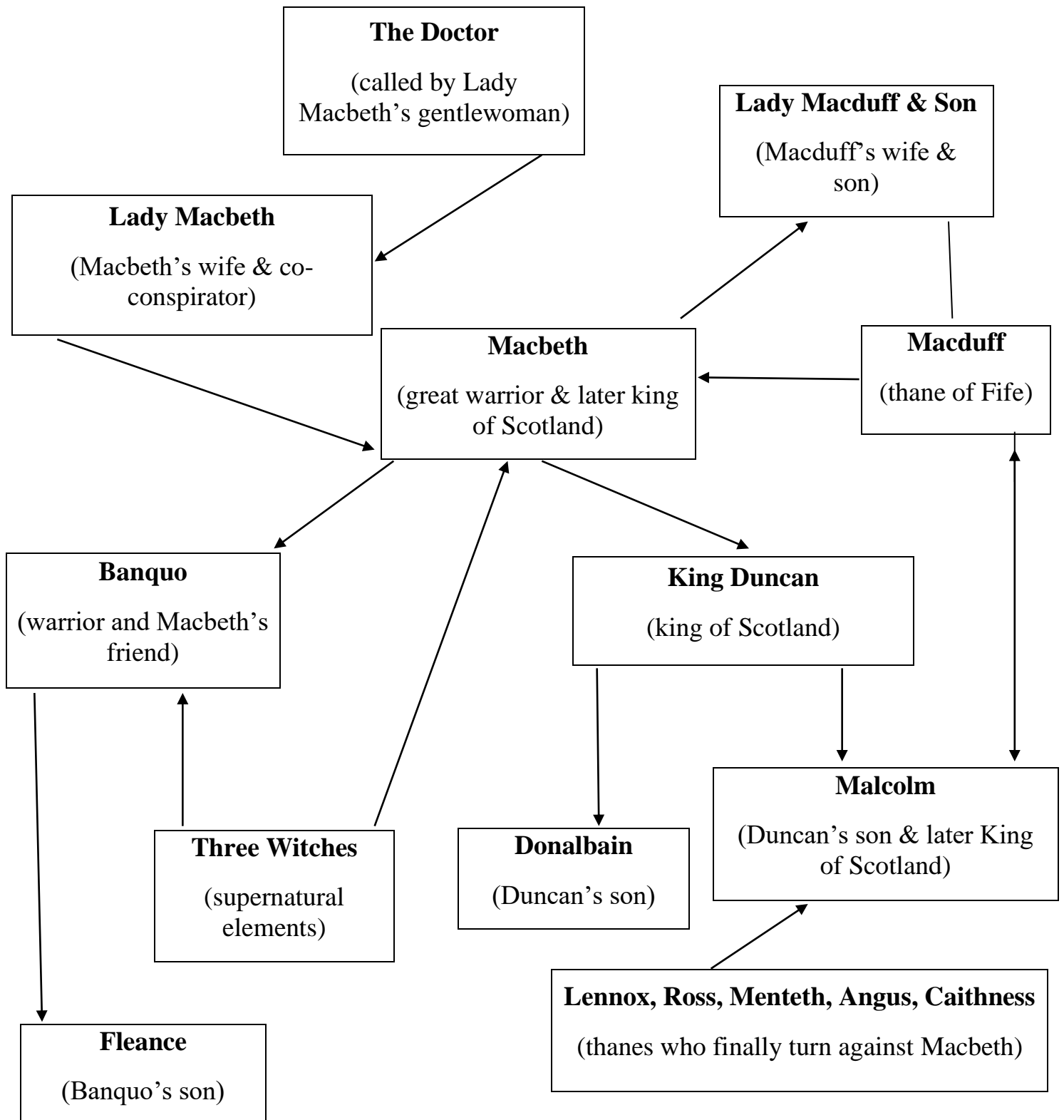

Character and Action Map of Macbeth



Description of Action as Shown in the Map

- The Three Witches meet Macbeth and reveal prophecies to Macbeth for being the king of Scotland
- They also reveal prophecies that Banquo's sons would be the kings of Scotland.
- Lady Macbeth encourages Macbeth to kill King Duncan
- Macbeth murders King Duncan
- Macbeth also arranges the murder of Banquo and his son, Fleance. Banquo is murdered but Fleance manages to escape in the darkness
- Macbeth then arranges the murder of Lady Macduff and her son
- Macduff joins forces with Malcolm (the son of King Duncan) against Macbeth
- Lennox, Ross, Menteith, Angus, Caithness support in the battle against Macbeth
- Macduff (the Thane of Fife) ultimately kills Macbeth
- Malcolm becomes the King of Scotland.
