1660-1700 The Restoration

1700-1745 The Augustan Age or the Age of **Pope** 

1745-1785 The Age of Sensibility or the Age of **Johnson** 

1785-1832 The Romantic Period

1832-1901 The Victorian Period

1901-1945 The Modern Period
