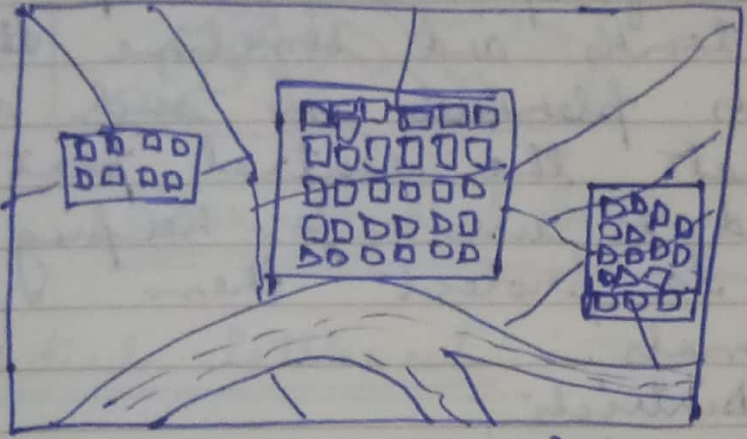

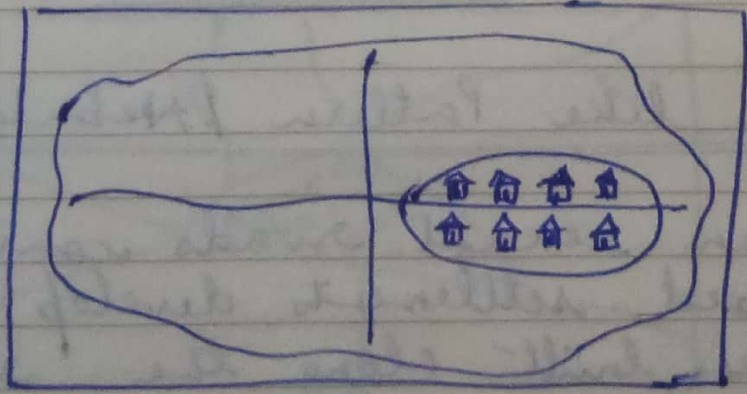

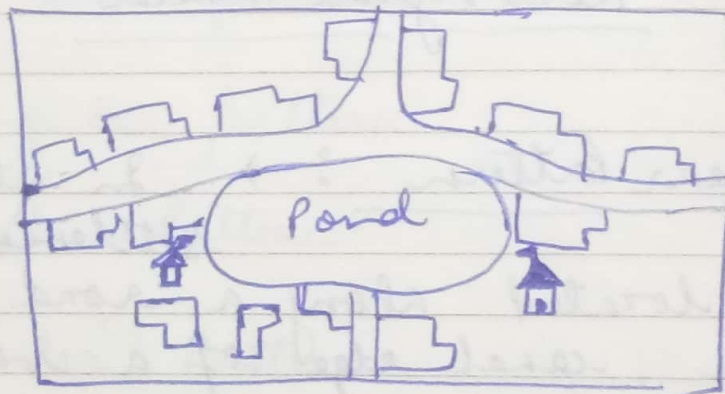

(iv) Star like Pattern / Nebular Pattern

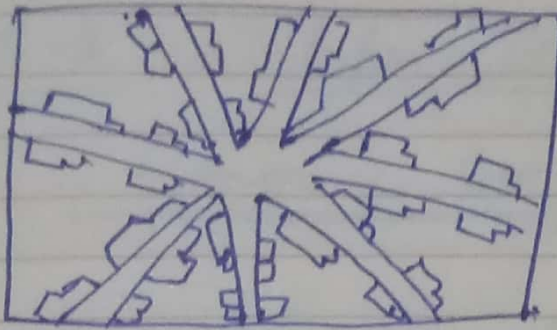
→ When several roads converge, star shaped settlements develop by the houses built along the roads.

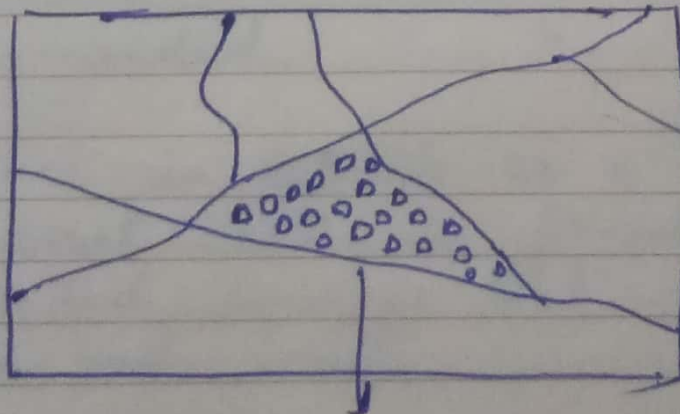
Star Shaped Pattern
